

Cadet Attendance Policy Statement Effective September 3 2019

- General Training: 80%: Exceptions for school or other significant reasons will be excluded from the calculations **ONLY** when reported prior to the absence through the website <http://www.105armycadets.ca>
- Corps Planned activities (FTX's, Poppy Campaign): 80%. These are advertised well in advance, there should be virtually no reason for failure to attend other than death in the family or similar.
- Community Service: 70%: Cadets **MUST** achieve attendance in seventy percent of the grand total of all hours of Community Service that the Cadet Corps participates in order to complete the requisite Community Service requirement for completion of their Star Level. As you are aware, if one section of the training requirements is incomplete, Cadets can be advanced into the next training level, but will not receive recognition for completing the previous Star Level and will not receive the requisite promotion that goes along with it.
- Mandatory Activities: 100%: There are only three activities which are considered Mandatory. Two are proscribed by the program:
- Bivouac Field Training FTX or NGTA Silver & Gold Expedition Weekend, & Navigation and Trekking FTX.
- NOTE, exception: As the Biv FTX usually occurs during the initial intake period at the beginning of the training year, those late joiners (those enrolled after the FTX date) can have the opportunity to make up for it during other field activities if the activities permit. Also, the NGTA may arrange a spring time NGTA Silver & Gold Expedition Weekend for **late joiners only**.
- The third mandatory activity is the Annual Ceremonial Review.
- If for any reason the dates for the Corps Planned activities have to change, consideration will be given for authorized absences.

General Training:

Expectations for any Cadet to complete the full training provided by the program is laid out in the CCO policy. The requirement for any Cadet to complete any module of the required training is 70% (excluding any performance or enabling objectives [PO's or EO's] which capture the level of learning). Therefore a general attendance level of 80% should enable any Cadet to be present for 70% of any given module.

Corps Planned Activities include:

NGTA Silver & Gold Expedition Weekend, Bivouac & Survival FTX, 7th Toronto Regiment CF Familiarization, Winter Preparation MST Day, Winter Indoctrination FTX, Orienteering MST Day, Navigation / Trekking FTX, and Annual Ceremonial Review.

Community Service activities include, but are not limited to:

Cadet Corps fundraising activities (i.e. grocery bagging), Legion Poppy Campaign, Santa Claus Parade, Bread and Honey Parade, Legion clean up, Autism Walk, Remembrance Vigil, Remembrance Parades

Failure to meet the minimum attendance will result with the repercussions being: No promotion, no participation in yearend fun exercise or activity and being given a low priority for their camp selections.
