## IMPORTANT REMINDERS FROM OUR Commanding Officer, Capt. Cross

1. Parents are expected to either:
  1. Monitor their cadet's Cadet365 email account for information OR
  2. Visit the website to check for current information (after requesting a password from the Admin Officer [105Army@cadets.gc.ca](mailto:105Army@cadets.gc.ca)).
2. If a cadet signs up for any event, they are **EXPECTED to show** –  
There were approximately 30 cadets who did not show up for the most recent ADA, which costs the program hundreds of dollars in staff, bussing, food etc. If your cadet is sick, please remember to report their absence using the website [absence reporting form](#).
3. It is important that cadets **arrive on time** for parade night on Tuesday evenings. Cadets must arrive between 6:15 and 6:30pm - Opening parade is at 6:45pm. Cadets who miss the opening parade will also miss announcements and valuable class time. \*\*Frequent lateness may impact their chances for senior cadet appointments or summer training opportunities.
